Objective: I can read and spell words using the prefixes **'re'** and **'anti.'**

A prefix is a letter or a group of letters that can be added to the beginning of a word to make a new word.

- The prefix 're'- means 'again' or 'back' when you add it to a root word.

Example

to appear again = reappear.

- The prefix 'anti'- means 'not' or 'against' when you add it to a root word.

Example

not social = antisocial.

resend	return	antivirus
reapply	reopen	antibiotic
