

# SPELLING LIST 21

**Objective:** I can read and spell words using the suffixes 'ous' and 'ation'.

A suffix is a letter or a group of letters that can be added to the end of a word to make a new word.

- Sometimes the spelling of the root word is unchanged when -ment, -ness, -ful or -less is added.

Example: **Joy + -ous = joyous.**

- Sometimes the spelling of the root word is changed when -ment, -ness, -ful or -less is added.

Example: **Humour + -ous = humorous.**

<b>Root word changes</b>	
<b>-ous</b>	<b>-ation</b>
famous	invitation
glamorous	Location
infectious	preparation
