

# SPELLING LIST 24

**Objective:** I can spell the long *a* sound spelt as *ey*, *eight* or *ei*.

The letter patterns *ei*, *eight* and *ey* often make the long *a* sound, as in game.

Examples:



How much do I weigh?



Eight balls



Greyhound

There is no rule for these spelling patterns. They just have to be learned.
