

SPELLING LIST 21

Objective: I can read and spell words using the prefixes 'un,' 'dis' and 'mis.'

A prefix is a letter or a group of letters that can be added to the beginning of a word to make a new word. The prefixes un-, dis- and mis- all have negative meanings.

Examples

not behaving = misbehave

not happy = unhappy

not similar = dissimilar

-un	-mis	-dis
unknown	misprint	disapprove
uneven	misbehave	disregard
unaware	misspell	dissimilar
unhappy	mistreat	dislike
unequal	mistrust	disappoint
unpaid	mismatch	displease
