Please Travel Smart on your journey to school to help reduce the impact of traffic.



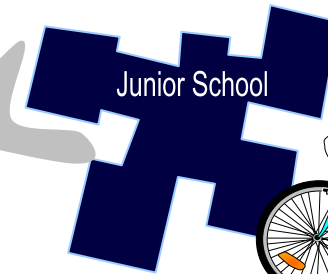

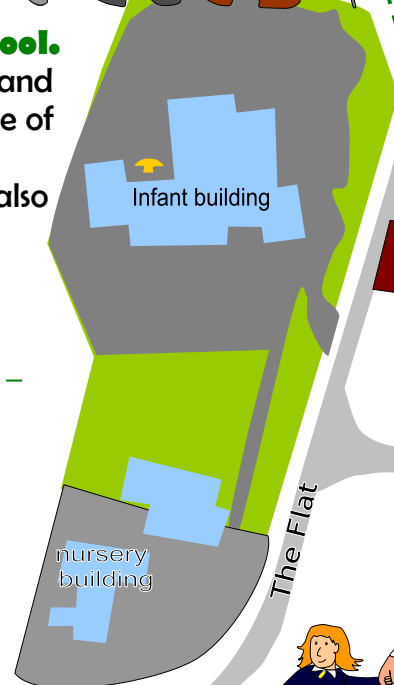


If scooting or cycling to school saves a car journey why not think about travelling this way?
